

MEET NEW LION SHANNON NIXON

Lion Shannon is an Anne Arundel County native and a Human Resources Professional who developed an early passion for community service over twenty years ago while serving in the United States Air Force. After separating from the military, Lion Shannon returned to Maryland, continued volunteer efforts with Catholic Charities, and went on to complete her graduate degree while working with various DOD agencies. From 2014 to 2017 Lion Shannon served as an HR supervisor to servicemembers in Kaiserslautern, Germany where she promoted community service within her department. While serving overseas she inspired her staff to volunteer at the Fisher House, located in Landstuhl, Germany and Kaiserslautern Middle School.

Upon her return from Germany in 2017, she founded a small nonprofit, Community Helping Hands, based out of Laurel, MD where she and her volunteers assist senior citizens in local communities. This experience gives her a deep appreciation for how community service seeks to improve the quality of life for residents of Anne Arundel County. In her spare time Lion Shannon enjoys traveling, reading, camping, tending to her houseplants, hiking, and serving her community.

DIABETES PRESENTAION

On Tuesday, January 24th, Penny Tilghman a registered nurse with over 30 years of experience working in the field of health care and currently serving as the Director of Evidence-Based Programs with the Department of Aging and Disabilities gave a very rounded presentation on diabetes prevention. She employed a detailed PowerPoint on healthy eating and exercise and then engaged the Severn River Lion's Club with an educational activity testing our knowledge of prevention and healthy lifestyle practices around diabetes.
