Lions "adopt" a collection box, check it monthly, pick up donated eyeglasses, and bring them to a club meeting for central collection before the semi-annual District sorting where our club and other Lions Clubs in the District meet to sort through thousands of pairs of eyeglasses. They are prepared for sanitizing and grading before they are shipped to many third world countries as part of the international campaign to help improve quality of living. Currently, SRLC has more than a dozen large blue and gold collection boxes around the area where surplus eyeglasses and hearing aids can be deposited.
